



***Calcasieu Parish Public Works crews will begin removing debris from floodaffected homes near the Sabine River this week. Residents are asked to bring all flood debris to the roadside for pickup and contact the parish to make sure their address is on the list of homes with debris. The number to call is 337-721-3700 and residents are encouraged to call whether or not they have placed the debris on the roadside. Residents should not wait for FEMA or insurance representatives to inspect the damage before bringing debris to the roadside. They are encouraged to take photographs and document the damaged items. Parish officials intend to complete debris removal by April 30, 2016.

***Calcasieu pet owners can take part in two low-cost drive-thru rabies clinics hosted by the Office of Animal Services. The clinics help prevent the spread of Rabies Infection in Calcasieu Parish and Louisiana State Code requires all dogs and cats over three months old be vaccinated and licensed. Once vaccinated the pet is required to wear a rabies license tag. Cat owners are encouraged to place the tag on a humane breakaway collar.

The vaccination and licensing fee for spay/neutered animals is \$8. Unaltered pets have a \$10.00 fee. Pet owners may pay by cash or check. No credit or debit cards will be accepted. Micro-chipping will also be available at the clinics. Clinic dates, time, and locations are:

The grant is funded annually by the Lake Charles/SWLA Convention & Visitors Bureau and is one of four grants the Arts Council administers. All applications must be received, not postmarked, by Friday, April 22nd, 2016 by 5 p.m. at the Arts Council office at Central School. Nonprofit organizations domiciled in Calcasieu Parish are eligible to apply for special projects and events occurring within the parish, and funds are dedicated for only marketing and promotional expenses such as billboards, advertising, and brochures. The grant is designed to increase an event's visibility and attendance through marketing efforts and to bolster tourism to the area. Applicants may submit one application and may request up to \$2,000 for a specific project. All projects must take place between June 15th, 2016 and July 14th, 2017. The SWLA Convention & Visitors Bureau Tourism Marketing Grant is a competitive grant program and not all applicants are guaranteed to be funded. Applicants compete only with other nonprofit arts organizations in Calcasieu Parish, so decisions about funding are made locally. To better accommodate their donors, <u>Lifeshare Blood Center</u> has adjusted the hours at their facility located at 214 Dr. Michael DeBakey Drive in Lake Charles. They will still be open Monday, Tuesday and Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and the first and third Saturday, 8 a.m. to Noon, but on Wednesdays they will open at 6:30 a.m. and close at 3 p.m. and on Thursday they will open at 10 a.m. and stay open until 8 p.m. Every 2 seconds a patient needs blood to live. They must rely on volunteer blood donors to live. Potential blood donors receive a mini-physical prior to the donation procedure, including a check of temperature, pulse, blood pressure and iron level. Donors must be age 16 or older (16 year olds require written parental consent), weigh at least 110 pounds, feel well and healthy at the time of donation, eat a good meal and increase fluid intake prior to donation. West Calcasieu Port awards bid for waterfront improvement work

SULPHUR, La, (April 4, 2016) - West Calcasieu Port officials announced today that it has awarded a construction contract to Orion Marine Construction, Inc. for \$1,589,632.10 for the replacement of bulkheading along the port's waterfront on the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway.

"The West Cal Port Board of Commissioners was impressed with the strong interest and participation in the highly competitive bidding process on the part of the marine construction industry," said West Calcasieu Port Director Lynn Hohensee. "Seven bids were received."

The bids were formally opened during a special port board meeting earlier in March.

"Incorporated in the construction project plan is the replacement of aged, deteriorated bulkhead with new steel bulkhead," Hohensee explained.

Underscoring the business-case need for the expanded barge basin, Hohensee noted that servicing commercial barge transportation operations along the Gulf Intracoastal Waterway is a critical component of the port's operations, and that the port has experienced an increased occupancy rate for its marine services facilities.

West Cal Port Engineer Chuck Stutes of Sulphur-based Meyer & Associates, Inc. has estimated that approximately 300 linear feet of 600-foot length of steel bulkheading will replace aged infrastructure that was installed in the 1970s, Significant funding support will come from a \$1,305,000 Capital Outlay Grant from the State of Louisiana.

Located on 190 acres 12 miles south of Interstate 10 just west of Highway 27, the West Cal Port has 7,000 feet of waterfront property on the GIWW.

Current tenant activity includes barge fleeting operations, dry-cargo barge cleaning, diesel engine repair, maritime construction operations, concrete manufacturing and concrete pumping services.
